

## YURI GAGARIN

Yuri Gagarin was born in the small village of Klushino, Russia (RSFSR in the Soviet Union), in 1934. He grew up with a love of aviation and joined a Soviet flight school at the age of 17. In 1960 he was chosen to be part of a group of cosmonauts trained to fly the spacecraft. 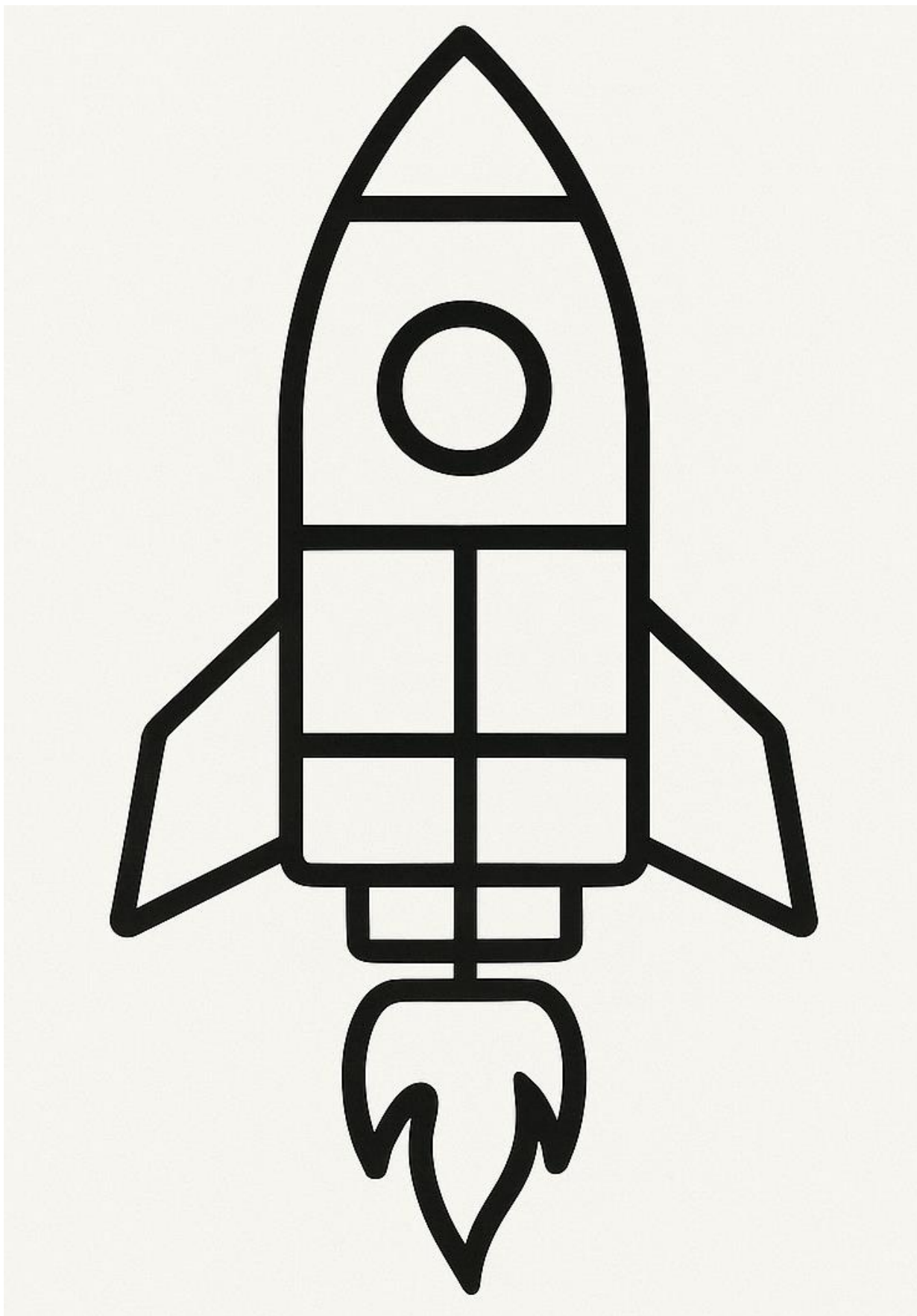
